Note: For students, there is a preference for joint pieces with faculty members, but self-written pieces may also be considered.

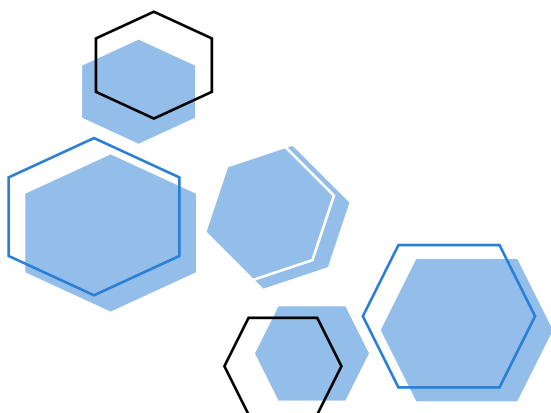
