CIS GRADUATES ITS CLASSES OF 2020 AND 2021

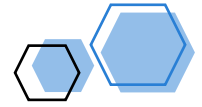
HBKU PASSES THE MILESTONE OF 1,000 GRADUATES

An internal ceremony was also held to recognize the graduating cohort and the Dean's List recipients for 2021.

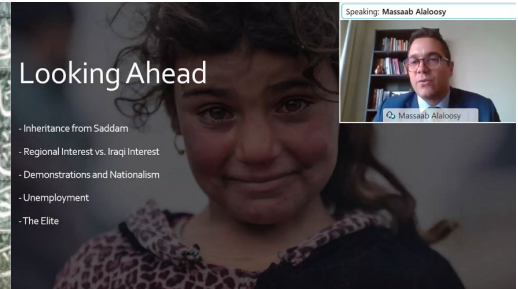
